

Counterfeit Policy Statement

MPE Electronics Ltd recognise that counterfeiting is a serious, global problem.

Counterfeiting of components poses a serious risk that can have a negative impact on both the worldwide economy and jeopardises the safety of individuals. As such, MPE Electronics Ltd is committed to preventing the introduction of counterfeit electronic components to the supply chain where reasonably & practicably within our control.

In order to protect our customers from sub-standard and/or counterfeit goods, MPE Electronics have robust supplier selection & monitoring procedures which are detailed within our ISO9001:2015 Quality Management System.

To help prevent the purchase of counterfeit or substandard components:

- All components shall be purchased from Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEM), where this is not possible;
 - Components shall be purchased from Authorised /Approved / Franchised distribution channels, where this is not possible;
 - Parts shall be purchased with full chain of custody to the Manufacturer, unless agreed with customer where / if this is not possible with relevant inspection processes put in place internally and at the suppliers.

MPE Electronics Ltd.'s Expectations of our Suppliers:

- Maintain robust Counterfeit component policies/procedures
- Investigate all incidents of suspected counterfeit electronic components and report the incident and outcome to MPE Electronics Quality Department if procured products are affected
- Make unusable all material confirmed as counterfeit and provide evidence to MPE's Quality Department
